1. INTRODUCTION

Greater Augusta Prevention Partners (GAPP), www.valleyprevention.com, through a grant made possible by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) and the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), furthers its mission by providing a youth programming resource inventory. The Central Shenandoah Valley Office on Youth serves as the fiscal agent for this grant. GAPP contracted with Knowledge Advisory Group, an evaluation and measurement consulting firm, www.KnowledgeAdvisoryGroup.com, to develop a resource inventory of youth programming within the cities of Staunton and Waynesboro, and Augusta County, Virginia. Data collection efforts encompassed several methodologies including research, professional surveys, and telephone interviews.
